- h. Margins: (Paper Size A4; Margins: Top & Bottom 2.54cm each, Left & Right 3.17cm each)
- **i. Spacing:** All texts must be double line spacing, including abstract and references. Text should be fully justified. The work must not exceed 15 pages from the title page to the last appendix.
- j. Format/Operating system: Works must be in Microsoft Words. PDF documents are not allowed.
- **k.** Font Size: All Fonts are Times New Roman with Size=12, unless stated otherwise).
